In addition, we check the primary data used such as kilometres driven, electricity consumption, gas consumption, etc.

You will receive a 'verification or assurance statement' that you can add to your carbon footprint. You will also receive a confidential report describing the verification activities carried out and suggestions for further improving your footprint calculation.
